

DOOCHIN FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

The Doochin Family Scholarship was created to support individuals who have been formerly incarcerated and are continuing their education at Nashville State. This scholarship is available to both full- and part-time students pursuing an Associate Degree.

Recipients may be awarded up to \$2,686 per academic year, depending on available funding.

To be considered, you must submit the NSCC Financial Aid and Scholarship Form via your myNSCC portal by June 30th each year. Early submission is strongly encouraged.

To be considered for this scholarship, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Must be a formerly incarcerated individual.
- Must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the verification process.
- Must be pursuing an Associate of Arts (AA), Associate of Science (AS), or Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree.
- Must be in good academic standing and meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) standards as defined by federal Title IV guidelines.

Incarcerated applicants should submit all required materials to a THEC Navigator or THEI Coordinator, who will forward the application to the Nashville State Community College Foundation.

Formerly incarcerated applicants should submit all materials directly to the NSCC Foundation Office, attention Ryan Parker, via email at ryan.parker@nsccl.edu. Please include "The Doochin Family Scholarship Application" in the subject line.

Applicable maintenance fee/tuition refunds will be credited to the scholarship except in cases when the student is also receiving federal Title IV benefits and totally withdraws. In such cases, the refund is credited back to the appropriate program(s) according to the NSCC "Return of Title IV Funds" Policy.
