

DOUG JAMESON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Doug Jameson Memorial Scholarship was created with the generous support of family, friends, faculty, and staff of Nashville State Community College. The Foundation is proud to continue to honor Doug's memory through this scholarship designed to provide financial support to students attending Nashville State Community College.

Recipients may be awarded up to \$1,000 per academic year, depending on available funding.

To be considered, you must submit the NSCC Financial Aid and Scholarship Form via your myNSCC portal by June 30th each year. Early submission is strongly encouraged.

To be considered for this scholarship, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the verification process.
- Be pursuing an Associate Degree or Technical Certificate
- Must be working with an Nashville State Student Success Advisor or Tennessee Reconnect Navigator.
- Be enrolled in at least six credit hours.
- Maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.
- Be in good academic standing and meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) standards as defined for federal Title IV financial aid programs

Applicable maintenance fee/tuition refunds will be credited to the scholarship except in cases when the student is also receiving federal Title IV benefits and totally withdraws. In such cases, the refund is credited back to the appropriate program(s) according to the NSCC "Return of Title IV Funds" Policy.
