### Recommended Language for Bequests

Countless individuals have chosen to create a lasting legacy by including a charitable bequest to Nashville State Community College Foundation in their will or trust. This powerful gesture reflects a deep commitment to student success and the NSCC Foundation's mission, ensuring that future generations benefit from their generosity. By directing a portion—or all—of their estate to the Nashville State Community College Foundation, they help shape lives long into the future. Recommended language to use:

"I/We hereby give \_\_\_\_\_ (could be dollar amount, percentage or specific assets) to the Nashville State Community College Foundation, 120 White Bridge Road, Nashville, TN 37209, to be used for the \_\_\_\_\_."

If you would like to create a permanent named endowment (\$10,000 minimum to establish an endowment) with a portion of the annual income designated for a particular purpose (scholarship, faculty support, academic program support) you can express your wishes this way:

"I/We give to the Nashville State Community College Foundation [Federal Tax ID 62-1567873] \_\_\_\_\_ (percent of my estate, dollars, property, securities, rest, residue or remainder of my estate) to establish the \_\_\_\_\_ (the name you wish the endowment to bear) Endowment for the benefit of the Nashville State Community College Foundation. The fund income, but not the principal, should be used for \_\_\_\_\_."

The Nashville State Community College Foundation shall have the authority and discretion to invest and reinvest such fund in accordance with policies established by its Board of Directors. The portion of the fund's value spendable annually for the designated purpose may also to be determined, from time to time, by the Board of Directors. If at any time in the future the need does not exist for the fund or should this conflict with any Federal, State or Local laws, statutes, regulations, or ordinances, the governing body of the Foundation shall have the authority to select an appropriate use for this fund that closely approximates my original intent. If, when the bequest is received, the gift or gifts to this fund fail to reach the minimum endowment level, the Foundation's Board of Directors will select an alternate use or combine this gift with other funds for similar purposes, keeping in mind my original intent.
