

NSCC FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

The Nashville State Community College Foundation Scholarship is made possible through the generous support of NSCC faculty and staff, local businesses and corporations, private foundations, individual supporters, and members of the Nashville State Foundation Board of Trustees. Created to expand access to higher education, this scholarship provides flexible financial support for students attending Nashville State Community College.

Recipients may be awarded up to \$1,000 per academic year, depending on available funding. Recipients are selected by the Welcome Center staff.

To be considered, you must submit the NSCC Financial Aid and Scholarship Form via your myNSCC portal by June 30th each year. Early submission is strongly encouraged.

To be considered for this scholarship, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the verification process.
- Must be pursuing an Associate Degree or Technical Certificate. Recipients must not have earned a prior Bachelor's Degree.
- Must be enrolled in at least six credit hours.
- Must have and maintain at minimum of 2.0 GPA
- Applicants must be in good academic standing and meet satisfactory academic progress standards, as measured for federal Title IV Programs.

To remain eligible for continued scholarship support, students must continue to meet the initial criteria and also:

- Maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.
- Successfully complete at least six credit hours each semester to qualify for disbursement in the following term.
- Re-enroll in a minimum of six credit hours for the upcoming semester.

Applicable maintenance fee/tuition refunds will be credited to the scholarship except in cases when the student is also receiving federal Title IV benefits and totally withdraws. In such cases, the refund is credited back to the appropriate program(s) according to the NSCC "Return of Title IV Funds" Policy.
