

NSCC FOUNDATION CULINARY ARTS SCHOLARSHIP

The Nashville State Community College Foundation Culinary Arts Scholarship is made possible through the generous support of NSCC faculty and staff, local businesses and corporations, private foundations, individual supporters, and members of the Nashville State Foundation Board of Trustees. Created to expand access to higher education, this scholarship provides flexible financial support for culinary arts students attending Nashville State Community College.

Recipients may be awarded up to \$1,000 per academic year, depending on available funding. Recipients are selected by the Welcome Center staff.

To be considered, you must submit the NSCC Financial Aid and Scholarship Form via your myNSCC portal by June 30th each year. Early submission is strongly encouraged.

To be considered for this scholarship, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the verification process.
- Must be pursuing an Associate Degree in Culinary Arts at Nashville State Community College.
- Must have completed at least 30 hours toward the Culinary Arts Associate's Degree, exclusive of transfer coursework.
- Must have a minimum of 2.5 GPA.
- Must be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours.
- Must agree to volunteer at the Tennessee Flavors event that occurs in the Spring.

Applicable maintenance fee/tuition refunds will be credited to the scholarship except in cases when the student is also receiving federal Title IV benefits and totally withdraws. In such cases, the refund is credited back to the appropriate program(s) according to the NSCC "Return of Title IV Funds" Policy.
