

DICKSON HIGH NOON ROTARY SCHOLARSHIP

The Dickson High Noon Rotary Scholarship is generously funded by the High Noon Rotary in Dickson, TN. This scholarship was created to expand access to higher education by providing flexible financial support to students enrolled at Nashville State Community College Dickson Campus.

Recipients may be awarded up to \$500 per academic year, depending on available funding.

To be considered, you must submit the NSCC Financial Aid and Scholarship Form via your myNSCC portal by June 30th each year. Early submission is strongly encouraged.

To be considered for this scholarship, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the verification process. Students will be considered for this scholarship if their Expected Family Contribution (EFC) is above the Pell Grant eligibility range but they still demonstrate financial need as determined by the Financial Aid Office.
- Must be pursuing an Associate Degree or Technical Certificate and must not have previously earned a Bachelor's Degree.
- Must be residents of Dickson County at the time of application and have Nashville State Community College Dickson Campus as their primary campus of attendance.
- Be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours and have completed at least one semester at Nashville State.
- Maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5.

Applicable maintenance fee/tuition refunds will be credited to the scholarship except in cases when the student is also receiving federal Title IV benefits and totally withdraws. In such cases, the refund is credited back to the appropriate program(s) according to the NSCC "Return of Title IV Funds" Policy.
