

JACOB ROBERTS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Jacob Roberts Memorial Scholarship supports students pursuing an Associate Degree in Computer Information Systems who demonstrate strong academic performance.

Recipients may be awarded up to \$500 per academic year, depending on available funding.

To be considered, you must submit the NSCC Financial Aid and Scholarship Form via your myNSCC portal by June 30th each year. Early submission is strongly encouraged.

To be considered for this scholarship, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Must be pursuing an Associate of Applied Science in Computer Information Systems.
- Must not have previously earned a Bachelor's degree.
- Must be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours.
- Must have completed at least twelve credit hours of Computer Information Systems coursework with a minimum GPA of 2.75.
- Must be in good academic standing and meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) standards as defined for federal Title IV programs.

To remain eligible for continued scholarship support, students must continue to meet the initial criteria and also:

- Maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75.
- Successfully complete at least six credit hours each semester to qualify for disbursement in the following term.
- Re-enroll in a minimum of six credit hours for the upcoming semester.

Applicable maintenance fee/tuition refunds will be credited to the scholarship except in cases when the student is also receiving federal Title IV benefits and totally withdraws. In such cases, the refund is credited back to the appropriate program(s) according to the NSCC "Return of Title IV Funds" Policy.
