

The Roberts - Williams Memorial Scholarship is in memory of Ms. Lisa Sheucraft Roberts and Mr. Richard Williams. The scholarship was founded by Mr. Williams due to the untimely passing of Ms. Roberts and was subsequently changed to add Mr. Williams upon his death. Ms. Roberts and Mr. Williams were faculty members at Nashville State Community College in Computer Information Systems and Business Management Technology respectively. Each recipient is awarded a maximum of \$1,000 each year. Awards will be made contingent upon available funding.

To qualify, please submit your NSCC Financial Aid and Scholarship Form through your myNSCC. You must complete this form each year by May 31st. We recommend that you submit your form early. Scholarships are awarded to qualified applicants on a first-come, first-awarded basis until funds are expended.

This scholarship is awarded to qualified applicants based on the following criteria:

- Applicants must be a single parent.
- Applicants must be enrolled full-time in a Computer Information Technology (CITC) or Business (BUSN) program.
- Applicants must have completed at least 12 credit hours of college-level coursework in their program of study and maintain a 3.0 grade point average.
- Applicants must be in good academic standing and meet satisfactory academic progress standards, as measured for federal Title IV Programs.
- Applicants must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

Students who receive the Roberts Williams Memorial Scholarship in the fall semester must continue to meet the criteria listed above to remain eligible for the spring disbursement of the scholarship.

Applicable maintenance fee/tuition refunds will be credited to the scholarship except in cases when the student is also receiving federal Title IV benefits and totally withdraws. In such cases, the refund is credited back to the appropriate program(s) according to the NSCC "Return of Title IV Funds" Policy.
